Physical Structure

A hard tough timber, harder than Scots Pine, and slightly stronger in bending and toughness. Although quite a hard timber it is still very workable with tools, especially for mouldings. It can be glued, nailed, jointed with screws. Difficult to treat heartwood

Moderately durable – 10 -15 years ground contact, 80 -100 years outdoor exposure
